The apprentice completes the NVQ, the Certificate in Teaching and Learning in Schools, Key Skills Communication, Application of Number and Information Technology and a short course on Employment Rights and Responsibilities.

Delivery: Learning is usually provided by attendance at a series of small group learning sessions arranged according to the employers requirements, normally in the evenings. The NVQ is assessed by observation in the workplace and testimony of the learner's practice, supported by questioning of knowledge to provide evidence of competence.

Cost: There is no charge for learners under 19 yrs. Cost for over 19 years is negotiated depending on the employers other contributions, such as time for study during working hours or provision of access to the internet with a minimum charge of £100 for registration.
