

Service Changes 1st November 2015

Service 1 – Wessex Bus: (Bristol – Cribbs Causeway) This is a new bus service that will operate between Bristol Union Street to Cribbs Causeway via Whiteladies Road, Blackboy Hill, Westbury-on-Trym and Henbury. The new service will operate 7 days a week and will be at frequent intervals with peak and daytime frequencies of every 7 to 10 minutes Monday to Saturdays, evening journeys every 30 minutes and Sundays every 15 minutes.

Service 60 – Stagecoach: (Dursley – Thornbury) New service serving Dursley, Wotton-under-Edge, Charfield, Falfield and Thornbury with at least 4 journeys in each direction Monday to Friday and 3 journeys on Saturdays. Service supported by Gloucestershire County Council. Please refer to Traveline for new timetable.

Service 87 – Severnside Transport: (Wotton-Under-Edge – Thornbury) Route and timetable change to improve reliability and punctuality of route, service will now serve Wotton-under-Edge, Charfield, Falfield and Thornbury with at least 3 journeys in each direction Monday to Friday only. The section between Cribbs Causeway and Thornbury will be served by service 622 on a similar frequency as before.

Service 88 – Stagecoach: (Dursley – Bristol) Intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route or frequency.

Service 502 – Wessex Bus: (Bristol Parkway – Shirehampton) Sunday service cancelled at request of Bristol City Council due to commercial operator running same route. No change to Monday to Saturday timetable. Service 18 operates an hourly Sunday service on this route.

Service 622 – Severnside Transport: (Cribbs Causeway – Chipping Sodbury) This service has been reverted back to serve Chipping Sodbury to Cribbs Causeway via Almondsbury, Olveston, Alveston, Thornbury, Tytherington, Rangeworthy and Yate following passenger requests.

Frequency will be approximately every 90 mins Monday to Saturday, the service will no longer serve Tetbury or Old Sodbury, please refer to Traveline for new timetable. No change to Sunday Service run by Wessex Bus.

Service 625 – Severnside Transport: (Severn Beach – Southmead Hospital) Intermediate running times are revised across Monday to Saturday to improve reliability and punctuality due to traffic problems at certain points along the route. The service will now run at a 90 minute frequency Monday to Saturday and with additional journeys during peak times, please refer to Traveline for new timetable. No change to Sunday Service run by Wessex Bus.

Service changes 6th December 2015

Service 1 – First Bus: (Cribbs Causeway – Bristol – Broomhill) Intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route or frequency.

Service 2 – First Bus: (Cribbs Causeway – Bristol – Stockwood) Intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route or frequency.

Service changes 12th December 2015

Service 12: – Wessex Star (Bristol – UWE Frenchay Campus) Service cancelled by the operator, services 19, 70, 71 and 72 run a similar route.

Service 13: – Wessex Star (Bristol – Fishponds - UWE Frenchay Campus) New non term timetable Monday to Saturday every 12 minutes throughout the day. Intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation during term time to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route.

Service X14: – Wessex Star (Bristol – M32 - UWE Frenchay Campus) Term time only, intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation during term time to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route.

Service 19: – Wessex Star (Bristol – UWE Frenchay Campus) New non term timetable Monday to Friday every 30 minutes throughout the day. Intermediate running times will be revised across all days of operation during term time to improve reliability and punctuality, no change to route.
