Saturday 27 to Monday 29 May  
(Bank Holiday weekend) also

**Network Rail will be working to prepare for our new trains which are due to enter service later this year.**

Train services through Didcot Parkway, Swindon, Chippenham and Bristol Parkway will be amended.

High Speed trains between London, Bristol and South Wales will be diverted and rail replacement services will operate on routes through Swindon.

## Saturdays 27 May and 10 June, and Bank Holiday Monday 29 May

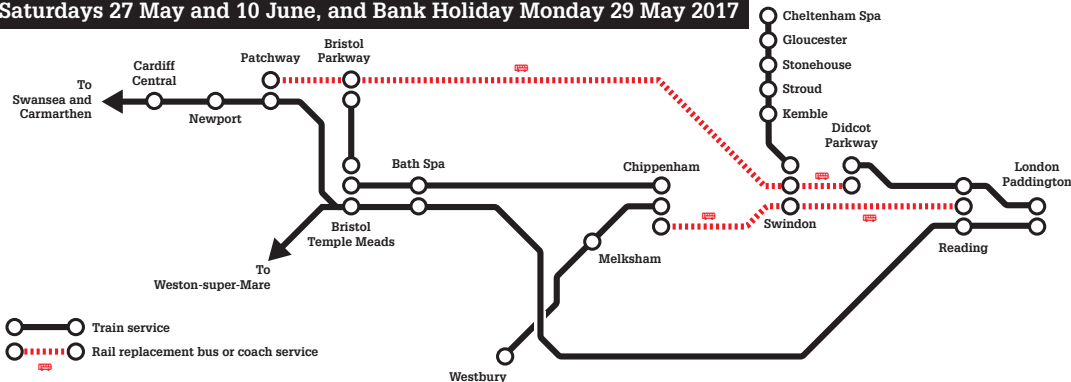
- Two High Speed trains each hour between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. One of these continues to Swansea, calling at Patchway instead of Bristol Parkway
- Customers for Bristol Parkway should change at Bristol Temple Meads
- Customers for Chippenham should change at Bath Spa
- One High Speed train each hour between Chippenham and Bristol Temple Meads

- One local train every two hours between Chippenham and Westbury
- One local train each hour between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa

### Summary of rail replacement buses

- One service every half hour from Reading to Swindon, extending to Chippenham on an hourly basis
- One service each hour from Didcot Parkway to Patchway, calling at Swindon and Bristol Parkway

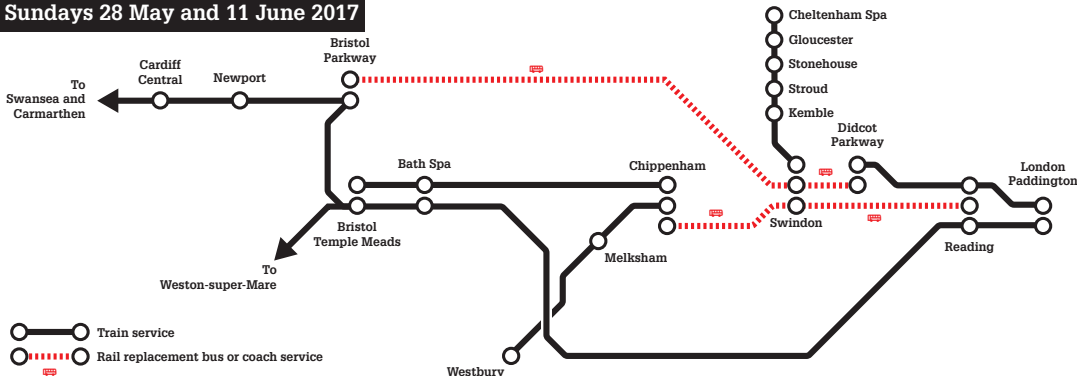
- Two High Speed trains each hour between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. One of these continues to Swansea via Bristol Parkway
